

Rosa's Body Part Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and understand basic body parts in French.

Read the story below carefully. Then, answer the questions. Use the word bank to help you with your spelling.

Rosa the parrot loves to teach her friends new words. Today, she is in the garden with Max the monkey. Max is getting ready for a big race. Rosa points to her own body to teach Max the French words. She touches her head and says, 'tête'. Max laughs and touches his own head too. Then, Rosa points to her long arm and says, 'bras'. She shows him her hand, which is her 'main'. Max jumps up and down on his strong leg, which is a 'jambe'. Finally, Rosa points to her foot, her 'pied'. 'My whole body is moving!' says Max. 'That is my corps,' Rosa explains. Max is happy because he can now name all his body parts in French. He is ready to run, jump, and play. Rosa loves helping her friends learn. It is a sunny day for learning and playing together in the park.

Word bank: tête (head) · bras (arm) · main (hand) · jambe (leg) · pied (foot) · corps (body)

1. Which animal is Rosa teaching in the garden? (1 mark)

2. What is the French word for 'head' used in the story? (1 mark)

3. Why is Max getting ready to move his body? (2 marks)

4. How do we know that Rosa is a good teacher? (2 marks)

5. Which body part do you think is the most important for running? Why? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Max the monkey. Label his head, arm, and leg using the French words from the word bank.



Extension challenge: Can you name three more body parts in English and find out what they are in French?
