

Rosa the Parrot's Body Parts Adventure

Learning objective: To learn and identify French words for parts of the body.

Read the sentences below. Look at the word bank to help you. Fill in the gaps with the correct French words. You can do it!

Hello! I am Rosa. I love to learn. Today we are looking at body parts. My friend has a strong tête. He uses his bras to wave hello. He has a busy main that likes to draw. He stands on his sturdy jambe. He takes a step with his fast pied.

Word bank: tête (head) · bras (arm) · main (hand) · jambe (leg) · pied (foot)

3. 3. If you want to say 'foot' in French, which word do you use? (1 mark)

4. 4. Match the body part to the French word: Leg = _____ (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a funny monster. Label the head as 'tête', the arm as 'bras', and the foot as 'pied'.



Extension challenge: Can you say these words out loud to a partner? Ask them to point to their own head, arm, or foot when you say the French word.
