

Le Corps Humain avec Rosa le Perroquet

Explorez votre corps en français ! Join Rosa the parrot to master the language of anatomy.

- **La tête** is the French term for the head. Remember that 'la' indicates a feminine noun in French grammar.
- **Les yeux** refers to the eyes. Because 'yeux' is plural, we always use the article 'les'.
- **Le nez** is the word for the nose. It is a masculine noun, so it takes the article 'le'.
- **Les mains** describes the hands. Just like eyes, hands are plural, so we use 'les'.
- **Les jambes** are the legs. These are essential for movement and are always written with 'les' in plural form.
- **Les oreilles** refers to the ears. Even though it starts with a vowel, the plural article 'les' remains the same.

Did you know? Did you know? In French, we use different words for 'the' depending on the noun. We use 'le' for masculine nouns, 'la' for feminine nouns, and 'les' for all plural nouns! This is why we say 'le nez' but 'la tête'.
