

La Mode avec Rosa: French Clothes

Enfile ton style et apprends le français avec Rosa la perroquet!

- To say 'I am wearing', we use the phrase 'Je porte'. For example, 'Je porte un pantalon' means 'I am wearing trousers'.
- Colours follow the noun. 'Un pull rouge' means 'a red jumper'. The colour comes after the object.
- Use 'un' for masculine nouns like 'un t-shirt' and 'une' for feminine nouns like 'une jupe'.
- Plural items use 'des'. 'Des chaussures' translates to 'some shoes'.
- When describing clothes, remember that if the clothing item is feminine, your adjective might need an extra 'e' at the end.

Did you know? Did you know? In French, adjectives often change their spelling based on the gender of the noun. For example, if you have a blue shirt (une chemise bleue), you add an 'e' to the colour because 'chemise' is a feminine word!
