

## Rosa's Radiant Rainbow Challenge

*Learning objective: To identify, spell, and apply French colour vocabulary to describe items and justify preferences using adjectives.*

Rosa the parrot has hidden objects around the classroom, each a different colour. Look at the French colour clues provided. Match the French word to the correct English translation, then use the sentence starters to describe the objects in full French sentences. For the Greater Depth questions, explain your reasoning using the target language.

*Word bank: rouge · bleu · jaune · vert · orange · violet · rose · noir · blanc · marron*

**1. Translate the following colours: 1) Le ciel est bleu. 2) La pomme est rouge. 3) L'herbe est verte. (3 marks)**

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**2. Using the word bank, write a sentence describing a zebra's stripes (noir et blanc). (2 marks)**

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**3. Explain why French adjectives for colours change depending on whether the object is masculine or feminine (e.g., 'vert' vs 'verte'). (3 marks)**

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**4. Justify your answer: If you were painting a picture of a sunset, which three colours from the list would you choose and why? (3 marks)**

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**5. Compare and contrast: How does the French word 'orange' differ from other colour adjectives when describing a plural noun? (2 marks)**

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6. What might happen if all objects in the world were 'blanc'? How would you describe the environment using your knowledge of French? (3 marks)

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**Draw:** Draw a magical garden scene where every plant, flower, and creature is a different colour. Label at least five items in the drawing using the correct French colour adjective.



*Extension challenge: Write a short poem in French (4 lines) describing your favourite room at home, focusing on the colours of the furniture. Use the structure: 'Dans ma chambre, il y a...' (In my room, there is...).*
