

Rosa's Weekly French Adventure

Learning objective: To recall and sequence the days of the week in French, and apply them within a creative context.

Rosa the parrot has a busy schedule! Help her organise her week by completing the sequence. Then, justify your choices by explaining why Rosa might choose specific days for her activities. Remember, in French, days of the week do not start with a capital letter unless they begin a sentence.

Word bank: lundi · mardi · mercredi · jeudi · vendredi · samedi · dimanche

1. Rosa starts her week on Monday (lundi). Write the next two days in the correct sequence. (2 marks)

2. If today is jeudi, what day was yesterday? Write your answer in French. (1 mark)

3. Rosa loves to visit the library on mercredi. Explain why she might choose this day instead of a weekend day. (2 marks)

4. Compare and contrast the French days of the week with the English days. Do you notice any patterns in their spellings or origins? (2 marks)

5. Rosa wants to host a party on samedi. Justify why this is a logical choice for a social gathering. (2 marks)

6. What might happen if all the days of the week were suddenly rearranged? How would this affect Rosa's routine? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a colourful 'Weekly Planner' wheel for Rosa. Divide the circle into seven segments, label each segment with the correct day in French, and draw a small icon for an activity she does on that day (e.g., a book for reading, a star for stargazing).



Extension challenge: Write a short diary entry in French for your own week (minimum 4 sentences). Use the structure: 'Le [day], je...' (On [day], I...). For example: 'Le lundi, je joue au football.'
