

Rosa's Weekly French Diary

Learning objective: To recall and accurately use the days of the week in French within a creative context.

Follow the drawing prompts below to create a visual diary for Rosa the parrot. Label your drawings using the French words provided in the word bank to show what Rosa does each day.

Draw: Create a seven-panel storyboard layout on your page. In each panel, draw Rosa the parrot engaged in a different activity corresponding to a day of the week. Use a clean, illustrative style with bright colours. Ensure there is enough space in each panel to write the French label clearly underneath the illustration.



Label words: lundi · mardi · mercredi · jeudi · vendredi · samedi · dimanche

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a scene for 'lundi' showing Rosa reading a book. Label the day.
2. Step 2: Draw Rosa playing football for 'mercredi'. Label the day.
3. Step 3: Draw Rosa painting a picture for 'vendredi'. Label the day.
4. Explain why it is important to remember that French days of the week do not start with a capital letter unless they begin a sentence.
5. Compare and contrast the French days of the week with the English days. Are there any patterns or linguistic similarities you notice?

6. Justify your answer: If Rosa says 'Je joue le samedi', what day is she playing? How do you know?
