

Rosa's Family Tree: French Vocabulary Flashcards

Learning objective: To identify, translate and use family-related vocabulary in French, including possessive adjectives and family structures.

Use these flashcards to practise your French family vocabulary. Rosa the parrot suggests saying the French words aloud to perfect your pronunciation. For a challenge, try to construct full sentences using the possessive adjectives (mon, ma, mes).

How do you say 'the family' in French?	Translate 'the father' and 'the mother' into French.
La famille	Le père et la mère
What are the French words for 'brother' and 'sister'?	Translate 'the grandfather' and 'the grandmother'.
Le frère et la sœur	Le grand-père et la grand-mère
How do you say 'my' when referring to a masculine noun (e.g., my father)?	How do you say 'my' when referring to a feminine noun (e.g., my mother)?
Mon (Mon père)	Ma (Ma mère)
Translate 'my parents' into French.	What is the French term for 'an uncle' and 'an aunt'?
Mes parents	Un oncle et une tante
How would you translate 'He is my brother' into French?	Translate 'She is my sister' into French.
Il est mon frère	Elle est ma sœur
What is the French word for 'the cousins' (plural)?	How do you say 'the baby' in French?
Les cousins	Le bébé
