

Rosa's French Café Assessment

Learning objective: To demonstrate understanding of vocabulary relating to food and drink, express preferences using 'j'aime' and 'je n'aime pas', and construct sentences about quantities and meals.

Read each question carefully. Ensure you use correct French spellings and include the appropriate articles (le, la, les, un, une) where necessary. Write your answers in the spaces provided.

Rosa the parrot is visiting a French market to help her friends choose breakfast. She says: 'Bonjour! Pour le petit-déjeuner, je mange une pomme et du pain. J'aime le fromage, mais je n'aime pas les céréales. Max le singe voudrait un chocolat chaud.'

1. Based on the passage, list two items Rosa eats for breakfast in French. (2 marks)

2. Translate the following sentence into English: 'Je n'aime pas les céréales.' (2 marks)

3. If you were ordering a drink at a café, how would you politely ask for an orange juice using the phrase 'Je voudrais'? (2 marks)

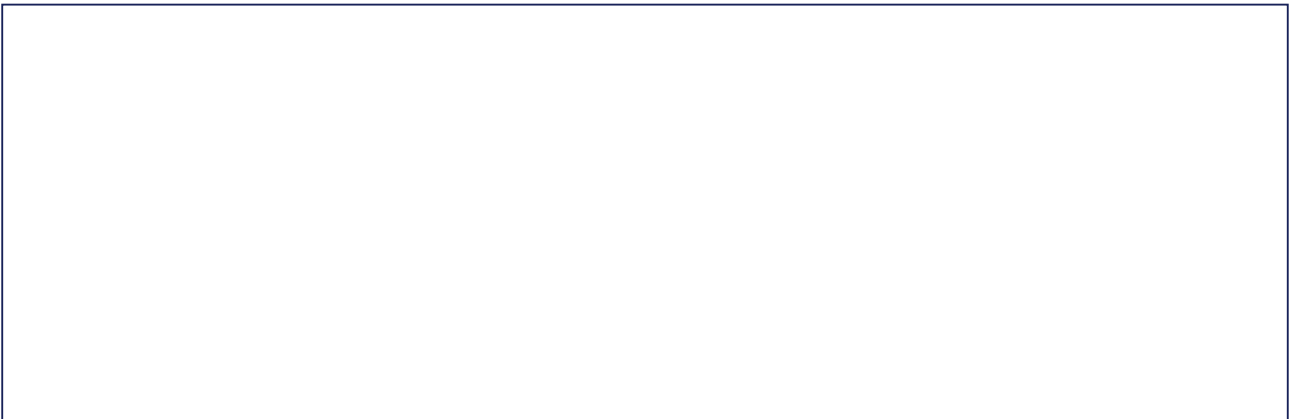
4. Categorise these foods into 'le' (masculine) and 'la' (feminine): le pain, la pomme, le fromage, la salade. (4 marks)

5. Explain why it is important to use the correct article (le/la/les) before a noun in French. How does it change the meaning or grammar of the sentence? (4 marks)

6. Compare and contrast the French breakfast habits mentioned in the passage with a typical breakfast you might eat. Write 3-4 sentences in French and English. (6 marks)

7. Extended Writing: You are writing a menu for Rosa's café. Create a menu featuring three items for breakfast and two drinks. Add prices in pounds (£) and justify why you chose these specific items for a healthy start to the day. (5 marks)

Draw: Draw a healthy 'petit-déjeuner' (breakfast) on a tray. Label at least three items in French.



Extension challenge: Total: /25. Imagine you are a food critic. What might happen if you served a dish that contained an ingredient the customer disliked? Write a short dialogue (4 lines) in French between a server and a customer who wants to change their order.
