

Rosa's Restaurant Review: French Food Diary

Learning objective: To use accurate French vocabulary to describe food preferences, justify likes and dislikes, and structure a review using adjectives and connectives.

Rosa the parrot has been visiting a French café! Use this template to write your own review of a meal. Use the word bank to help you construct sentences in French. Ensure you include a variety of opinions and justify your choices using 'parce que' (because).

Word bank: J'aime (I like) · Je n'aime pas (I do not like) · C'est délicieux (It is delicious) · C'est sain (It is healthy) · Parce que (Because) · Le petit-déjeuner (Breakfast) · Le déjeuner (Lunch) · Le dîner (Dinner) · Sucré (Sweet) · Salé (Salty)

1. Le Repas (The Meal): Which meal did you eat and what was on the menu? Describe the items in French. (2 marks)

2. Les Opinions: State whether you enjoyed the food or not. Use at least two different adjectives to describe the flavours. (3 marks)

3. La Justification: Explain why you liked or disliked the food. Use 'parce que' to provide a reason. (3 marks)

4. Comparaison: Compare this French dish to a meal you usually eat at home. How are they similar or different? (4 marks)

5. Analyse: Justify whether this meal would be considered a healthy choice for a balanced diet. Why might a nutritionist agree or disagree? (4 marks)

6. Creative Extension: What might happen to the restaurant's reputation if they changed the recipe of their most popular dish? Write a short prediction. (4 marks)

Extension challenge: Design a new menu for Rosa's café using at least six French food items. Categorise them into 'healthy' and 'treats'. Explain your choices using the vocabulary you have practised today.
