

## Rosa's Grand French Gala: A Dialogue Challenge

*Learning objective: To understand and apply French greetings and formal vs. informal social etiquette in a variety of contexts.*

Rosa the parrot is hosting a grand gala for her forest friends! You must act as her assistant. Read the social scenario for each guest below and choose the most appropriate French greeting from the word bank to complete the dialogue. Then, explain your choice based on formality.

*Word bank: Bonjour · Salut · Enchanté · Au revoir · Comment ça va ? · Bonsoir · À bientôt*

**1. Rosa greets a very distinguished elderly owl arriving at 7:00 PM. She needs to be polite. Which greeting should she use and why? (2 marks)**

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**2. Max the monkey spots his best friend, Kit the fox, across the room. How should Max greet him informally? Justify your choice. (2 marks)**

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**3. Pip the caterpillar has just been introduced to a new guest for the first time. What should Pip say to express 'pleased to meet you'? (2 marks)**

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**4. Compare and contrast: When would you choose 'Bonjour' over 'Salut'? Provide a specific social situation for each. (2 marks)**

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**5. The gala is ending. Write a short sentence in French that a guest might say to Rosa to signal they are leaving but will see her again soon. (2 marks)**

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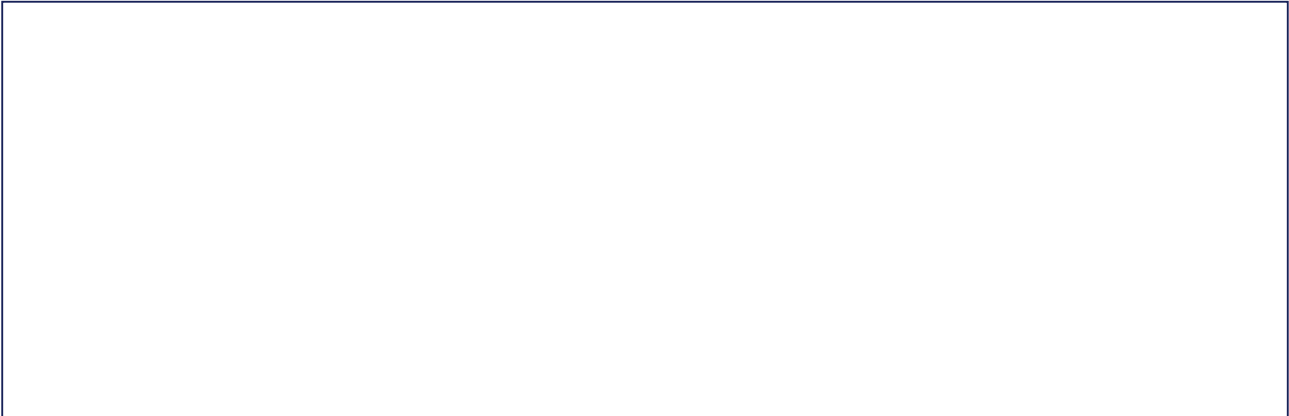
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**6. 6. What might happen if a student used 'Salut' instead of 'Bonjour' when addressing a Headteacher? Explain the importance of register in language. (2 marks)**

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**Draw:** Draw a scene of Rosa the parrot greeting different friends at the gala. Include speech bubbles for each character showing them using the correct French greeting for their specific friend.



*Extension challenge: Design a 'French Greeting Etiquette Guide' for other students. Create a table categorising greetings into 'Formal' and 'Informal'. Write a persuasive paragraph explaining why learning formal greetings is essential for building respect when travelling to French-speaking countries.*
