

Rosa's Multilingual Garden Party

Learning objective: To identify and use a range of French greetings and introductions in a creative context.

Help Rosa the parrot host a garden party for her friends! Follow the drawing steps below to illustrate the scene and label your work using the French vocabulary provided.

Draw: Draw a vibrant garden scene featuring Rosa the parrot standing on a wooden perch. Around her, draw three other characters from the BookFlik group (such as Pip, Nova, or Max) arriving at the party. Include speech bubbles coming from each character. The style should be colourful and cheerful, like a storybook illustration. Ensure there is space around the characters to write the French labels from the word bank.



Label words: Bonjour · Salut · Enchanté · Comment t'appelles-tu? · Je m'appelle... · Au revoir

Steps:

1. Label the speech bubble above Rosa where she asks a friend for their name. Which phrase from the word bank is most appropriate?
2. If Rosa meets a new friend at the party, she says 'Enchanté'. Explain why she would use this word instead of 'Salut'.
3. Write a short dialogue in French between two of your drawn characters as they arrive at the party.
4. Compare and contrast the social situations in which you would use 'Bonjour' versus 'Salut'. Justify your

choices.

5. What might happen if you used 'Salut' to greet a teacher or a headteacher? Explain the importance of formal versus informal greetings.

6. Create a new French greeting that is not in the word bank (e.g., relating to the time of day) and draw a symbol for it in the corner of your page.
