Learning objective: To recall and apply common French greetings and polite phrases appropriate for Year 5 learners.

Join Rosa the parrot on a linguistic adventure! Read each question carefully and select the best answer or provide the correct French term. You have 10 marks to earn!

Answer Key: 1. A (Bonjour), 2. True, 3. Salut, 4. C (Comment ça va?), 5. False (It means 'Nice to meet you'), 6. Merci, 7. B (À bientôt), 8. De rien, 9. False (It is formal), 10. Très bien. Extension logic: Pupils should explain that 'Salut' is informal and used with friends, while 'Bonjour' is formal/neutral.

Research and explain how French speakers might change their greeting depending on the time of day.
