

French Assessment: Expressing Opinions with Rosa the Parrot

Learning objective: To express likes and dislikes in French using opinion phrases and adjectives.

Hello! I am Rosa. I love to talk about what I like! Look at the pictures and the word bank to help you answer these questions. Read each question carefully and write your answers clearly.

Rosa the parrot is visiting a café. She looks at the menu and the activities on the table. She wants to tell her friends what she thinks using her favourite French phrases.

Word bank: J'aime (I like) · Je n'aime pas (I do not like) · J'adore (I love) · C'est (It is) · génial (great) · nul (rubbish) · le chocolat (chocolate) · le football (football) · la musique (music)

1. 1. Rosa sees a picture of a football. Write a French sentence to say 'I like football'. (2 marks)

2. 2. Rosa sees a picture of a rain cloud next to a game she does not like. Write a French sentence to say 'I do not like this'. (2 marks)

3. 3. Look at the word 'génial'. What does it mean in English? (2 marks)

4. 4. Complete this sentence: 'J'adore le chocolat. C'est _____!' (Use the word bank). (2 marks)

5. 5. Rosa asks: 'Do you like music?' Write a sentence in French to say 'I love music'. (2 marks)

6. 6. Look at the two items below: A slice of cake and a maths worksheet. Write two sentences. One saying what you like and one saying what you do not like. (4 marks)

7. 7. Extended Writing Task: Imagine you are writing a letter to Rosa. Tell her three things you like and one thing you do not like. Use full sentences. (10 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of your favourite food and your least favourite food. Label them in French using 'J'aime' or 'Je n'aime pas'.
