

Rosa the Parrot's Opinion Workshop

Learning objective: To learn and use French phrases to express opinions about activities.

Help Rosa the Parrot talk about her favourite things! Use the word bank to help you complete the sentences. Follow the examples to write your own ideas.

Rosa the parrot loves to share her thoughts! In French, we use 'J'aime' for things we like and 'Je n'aime pas' for things we do not like. Remember: 'J'adore' means you love it very much!

Word bank: J'adore - I love · J'aime - I like · Je n'aime pas - I do not like · le football - football · la lecture - reading · la musique - music · le dessin - drawing

1. Rosa loves reading. Look at the word bank. Write the French phrase for 'I love reading'. (2 marks)

2. Max the monkey does not like football. Write the French phrase for 'I do not like football'. (2 marks)

3. Zara the zebra likes drawing. Fill in the blank: _____ le dessin. (1 mark)

4. What do you like? Choose one activity from the word bank and write a sentence starting with 'J'aime...' (2 marks)

5. What do you not like? Use 'Je n'aime pas' to write a sentence about an activity. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of yourself doing an activity you love. Below your drawing, write: 'J'adore...' and the name of the activity.



Extension challenge: Can you ask a friend what they like in French? Try saying: 'Tu aimes...?' (Do you like...?) and see if they answer with 'Oui' (Yes) or 'Non' (No).
