Learning objective: To express personal preferences and opinions in French using key vocabulary and grammatical structures.

Join Rosa the parrot as she explores how to share what she loves! Read each question carefully and select the best answer to show your understanding of French opinion phrases.

8. 8. True or False: 'J'aime le chocolat' is a grammatically correct sentence. (1 mark)

9. 9. If someone says 'C'est génial!', are they being: A) Rude B) Angry C) Sad D) Positive * (1 mark)

10. 10. Translate: 'I like reading' into French (start with 'J'aime...'). (1 mark)
