

Mon École Idéale (My Ideal School)

Learning objective: To use French vocabulary related to school subjects, equipment, and classroom environment to describe a school setting.

Use your French vocabulary to illustrate your dream school environment. Follow the drawing prompt and label your creations using the provided word bank. Ensure your labels are spelled correctly in French.

Draw: Create a detailed layout of your ideal school. Include at least one classroom with desks, a library space, and an outdoor playground area. Draw in a clear, architectural style. Use labels to identify each zone using the French vocabulary provided. You may use colour to represent different zones (e.g., green for the playground, blue for the library).



Label words: la salle de classe (classroom) · le bureau (desk) · la bibliothèque (library) · la cour de récréation (playground) · le cahier (exercise book) · la trousse (pencil case) · les crayons (pencils) · la cantine (canteen)

Steps:

1. Label five different areas or objects in your drawing using the French words provided in the word bank.
2. Explain why you chose to include a 'bibliothèque' in your design. Use a full sentence in French or English.
3. Compare and contrast your drawing with a standard classroom. What makes your design more effective for learning?
4. Justify your answer: If you were the headteacher, which room would be the most important to have, and

why?

5. What might happen if your school was designed without a 'cour de récréation'? Discuss the impact on student wellbeing.
6. Translate the phrase 'J'aime mon école' and explain how it reflects your feelings about your own school.
