

Ma Journée à l'École (My School Day)

Learning objective: To describe subjects, opinions, and daily routines at school using the French language.

Use this fact-file to map out your school life in French. Rosa the Parrot suggests using the word bank to help you express your opinions about different lessons. Ensure you use correct gender agreement (e.g., 'le' for masculine, 'la' for feminine) when writing about subjects.

1. Mes Matières Préférées: List three subjects you study and write a sentence for each explaining if you enjoy them or not. Use the word bank for guidance. (6 marks)

2. Explain why: Choose one subject you find difficult and one you find easy. Justify your choices using French adjectives from the word bank. (4 marks)

3. Compare and contrast: Compare your school day with a partner's. Identify one subject you both like and one you disagree on. Write your findings in French. (4 marks)

4. Justify your answer: If you were the Headteacher, which subject would you make longer each day? Explain your reasoning in French. (3 marks)

5. What might happen if: Imagine your school suddenly stopped teaching 'le sport'. How would this change the atmosphere of the playground? Write three sentences in French. (6 marks)

6. Creative Extension: Write a short, persuasive poem or 'poème' in French about why learning a new language like French is beneficial for your future. (5 marks)

Extension challenge: Challenge: Can you write a paragraph describing your ideal school timetable, including the times of day (e.g., 'à neuf heures') and the equipment you need for each lesson?
