

Rosa's Market Adventure: French Shopping Assessment

Learning objective: To demonstrate understanding of French vocabulary related to shopping, currency, and expressing preferences in a market context.

Read each question carefully. Rosa the parrot wants to see how well you can navigate a French market. Write your answers clearly in the spaces provided. Remember to use appropriate French nouns and articles.

Rosa is visiting a bustling market in a small French village. She wants to buy fresh ingredients for a picnic with her friends. She approaches a stall and sees a sign that says: 'Pommes: £2 le kilo' and 'Pain: £1.50 la baguette'.

1. Rosa wants to ask the shopkeeper for one kilogram of apples. Write the sentence she should use in French. (2 marks)

2. If Rosa buys one kilogram of apples and one baguette, calculate the total cost in pounds and pence. Show your working. (3 marks)

3. Translate the following phrase into English: 'Combien ça coûte, s'il vous plaît?' (2 marks)

4. Imagine Rosa thinks the price of a local cheese is too high. Write a French sentence she could use to express that it is expensive. (2 marks)

5. Explain why it is important to use 's'il vous plaît' when shopping in a French market. How does this impact the interaction with the shopkeeper? (4 marks)

6. Compare and contrast shopping at a small local market stall versus a large supermarket. Which would be better for finding fresh, local produce? Justify your answer. (4 marks)

7. Extended Writing: Rosa decides to buy a variety of items for a picnic. Write a short paragraph (4-5 sentences) in French describing what she buys, how much it costs, and why she chose these items. Include polite phrases. (8 marks)

Draw: Draw a French market stall with at least three different items for sale. Label each item with its correct French noun and its price in £.



Extension challenge: What might happen if Rosa misunderstood the currency or the weight measurements in the market? Explain the potential consequences of such a mistake. Total: /25
