

Rosa's Sports Day Masterpiece

Learning objective: To identify and use French vocabulary related to sports and physical activities, and to apply these labels to a visual representation.

Rosa the parrot wants to organise a grand sports tournament! Use the word bank to label your illustration of a sports scene. Ensure each sport is clearly represented in your drawing and use French vocabulary to describe the action.

Draw: Create a vibrant, detailed scene of an Olympic-style sports ground. The style should be colourful and energetic, similar to a comic book panel. Include a swimming pool, a football pitch, and a gymnasium. Draw diverse characters participating in different sports across the scene. Add speech bubbles for the characters using the phrase 'Je fais du sport!' and label each activity clearly with the French vocabulary provided in the word bank.



Label words: le football · le tennis · la natation · le basket-ball · le cyclisme · la gymnastique · faire du sport

Steps:

1. Identify three sports from your drawing that involve using a ball. Write the French terms below.
2. Explain why 'la natation' is a unique sport compared to the others listed in the word bank. Justify your answer.
3. If you were to add a new sport to this list, what would it be? Write the French name for it and explain your

choice.

4. Compare and contrast 'le cyclisme' and 'le football'. What equipment is necessary for both?
5. What might happen if the weather turned rainy during the tournament? Which sports would be most affected and why?
6. Write a short sentence in French describing which sport is your favourite, using the structure 'Mon sport préféré est...' followed by your chosen activity.
