

Rosa's French Time Challenge

Learning objective: To tell the time in French using o'clock, half past, quarter past, and quarter to, whilst developing fluency in digital and analogue formats.

Rosa the parrot is helping you master telling the time in French. Use these flashcards to test your knowledge. For each card, look at the English phrase on the front and try to recall the French equivalent before checking the answer.

What is the standard French question used to ask 'What time is it?'	Translate: It is one o'clock.
Quelle heure est-il?	Il est une heure.
Translate: It is three o'clock.	Translate: It is half past four.
Il est trois heures.	Il est quatre heures et demie.
Translate: It is quarter past six.	Translate: It is quarter to eight.
Il est six heures et quart.	Il est huit heures moins le quart.
Translate: It is midday.	Translate: It is midnight.
Il est midi.	Il est minuit.
