

Year 4 French Assessment: Transport

Learning objective: To identify and write French vocabulary related to modes of transport and express travel preferences.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you. Write your answers in the spaces provided.

Rosa the parrot is flying around the world! She likes to travel in many different ways. Sometimes she takes a train, and sometimes she rides a bike. Today, she is helping us learn how to talk about transport in French.

1. 1. Look at the pictures below (imagine a picture of a bus). What is the French word for this vehicle? (1 mark) (1 mark)

2. 2. Write the French words for these two vehicles: A bicycle and a plane. (2 marks) (2 marks)

3. 3. If you want to say 'I travel by car', which sentence starter do you use? Write the full sentence in French. (2 marks) (2 marks)

4. 4. Rosa asks: 'Do you like to travel by train?' Write a sentence saying 'I like to travel by train' in French. (3 marks) (3 marks)

5. 5. Look at the list: le bus, le train, le vélo, la voiture, l'avion. Which transport do you think is the fastest? Explain your answer in one simple French sentence using 'Je préfère...' (I prefer...). (2 marks) (2 marks)

6. 6. Extended Writing Task: Write 5 sentences in French about how you travel to school or on holiday. Use the word bank to help you. For example: 'Je voyage en bus. J'aime le bus.' (5 marks) (5 marks)

Draw: Draw your favourite way to travel and label it with the correct French word from the word bank.
