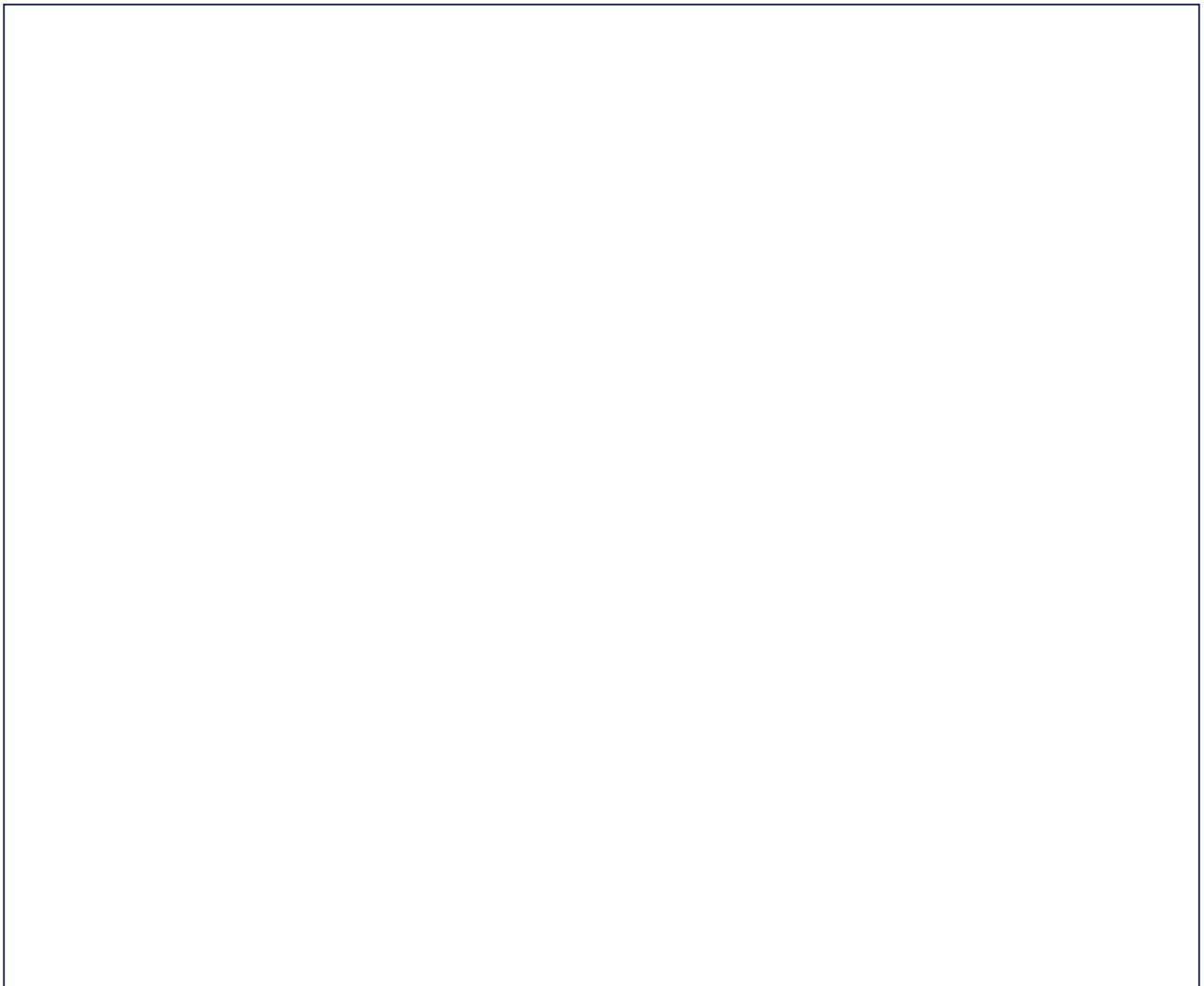


Rosa's Transport Adventure

Learning objective: To learn and use French vocabulary for different types of transport.

Hello! I am Rosa the parrot. Today we are learning how to say different types of transport in French. Follow the steps below to draw your own busy street scene. Make sure to label your drawings using the words in the box.

Draw: Draw a colourful scene of a town. Include a road for the car and bus, a pavement for the bicycle, a railway track for the train, and a bright blue sky for the plane. Keep the drawings simple and clear so you can write the French labels next to each vehicle.



Label words: le vélo (bicycle) · la voiture (car) · le bus (bus) · le train (train) · l'avion (plane)

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large road across the bottom of your page. Draw a red car on the road and label it.
2. Step 2: Draw a child riding a bicycle on the pavement and label it.
3. Step 3: Draw a big yellow bus driving behind the car and label it.
4. Step 4: Draw a train track in the corner with a train and label it.
5. Step 5: Draw a plane flying in the sky above the town and label it.
