

Rosa's French Transport Adventure

Learning objective: To learn and identify French words for different types of transport.

Read the sentences about Rosa the parrot's travels. Use the word bank to help you match the French word to the transport. Use the sentence starters to help you write your answers.

Rosa the parrot loves to travel! She flies to many places. Sometimes she goes by train. That is 'le train'. Sometimes she rides her bike, which is 'le vélo'. She also sees cars on the road, which are 'la voiture'. She travels to school by 'le bus'. When she goes very far, she takes 'l'avion'.

Word bank: le train · le vélo · la voiture · le bus · l'avion

1. Rosa rides her bike. What is 'bike' in French? (Sentence starter: In French, bike is...) (2 marks)

2. Rosa travels to school. What is 'bus' in French? (Sentence starter: In French, bus is...) (2 marks)

3. Rosa travels by car. What is 'car' in French? (Sentence starter: In French, car is...) (2 marks)

4. Rosa flies in a plane. What is 'plane' in French? (Sentence starter: In French, plane is...) (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of a bus and a train. Label them with their French names: 'le bus' and 'le train'.



Extension challenge: Can you ask a friend: 'Comment ça va?' and then tell them your favourite way to travel using: 'J'aime le/la...'
