

Rosa the Parrot's Transport Adventure

Learning objective: To learn and use French vocabulary for different types of transport.

Rosa the parrot is flying around the world! Look at the pictures and the words below. Use the word bank to help you answer the questions. Start your sentences with 'Je voyage en...' (I travel by...).

Word bank: le bus (bus) · le train (train) · le vélo (bicycle) · la voiture (car) · l'avion (plane)

1. Rosa wants to go to school. She decides to use her bike. Write in French: 'I travel by bicycle.' (2 marks)

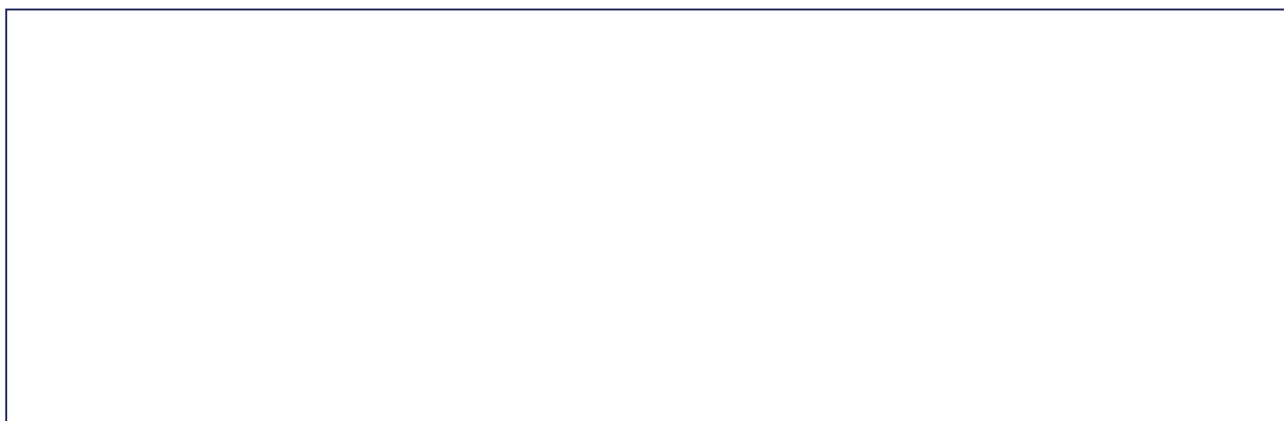
2. Look at this picture of a car. How do you say 'I travel by car' in French? (2 marks)

3. Rosa is going on a long holiday. She is going to fly. Write the French for 'I travel by plane.' (2 marks)

4. Fill in the blank: To travel by train, you say: 'Je voyage en _____.' (1 mark)

5. Which transport would you choose to get to the shops? Write your answer in French using: Je voyage en... (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Rosa the parrot sitting on top of a red bus. Label the bus in French.
