Learning objective: To identify and use common transport vocabulary in French, including gender and definite articles.

Rosa the parrot is helping us travel across France! Use these flashcards to practise your French transport vocabulary. Remember, French nouns have a gender (masculine 'le' or feminine 'la').

How do you say 'the train' in French?

Le train

How do you say 'the car' in French?

La voiture

How do you say 'the bicycle' in French?

Le vélo

How do you say 'the bus' in French?

Le bus

How do you say 'the plane' in French?

L'avion

How do you say 'the boat' in French?

Le bateau

How do you say 'the underground/tube' in French?

Le métro

How do you say 'on foot' in French?

À pied

How do you say 'the tram' in French?

Le tramway

Translate: 'I go by train'

Je vais en train

Translate: 'I go by car'

Je vais en voiture

What is the key difference between 'le' and 'la' when describing transport?

'Le' is used for masculine nouns and 'la' is used for feminine nouns.
