

En Route avec Rosa: Transport in French

Learning objective: To identify, translate, and use French vocabulary relating to transport, and to justify travel choices using connective phrases.

Join Rosa the parrot as she explores different ways to travel! Use the word bank to help you complete the exercises below, ensuring you use the correct articles (le, la, l', or en).

Word bank: le train (the train) · le bus (the bus) · le vélo (the bike) · la voiture (the car) · l'avion (the plane) · le bateau (the boat) · à pied (on foot) · rapide (fast) · lent (slow) · parce que (because) · préféré (favourite)

1. Translate the following sentences into French: 1) The car is fast. 2) I go by train. (2 marks)

2. Rosa is planning a journey to Spain. If she wants to travel quickly, which mode of transport should she choose and why? Justify your answer in French using 'parce que'. (3 marks)

3. Compare and contrast 'le vélo' and 'la voiture'. What are the environmental benefits of choosing a bicycle over a car? Write two sentences in English explaining your reasoning. (4 marks)

4. Complete this sentence: 'Mon transport préféré est _____ parce que c'est _____.'
(Use one noun and one adjective from the word bank). (2 marks)

5. Explain why it might be better to travel 'à pied' for short distances rather than using 'le bus'. (3 marks)

Draw: Draw a scene featuring Rosa the parrot travelling on your favourite mode of transport. Label the mode of transport in French.



Extension challenge: Imagine you are an explorer like Finn the dolphin. Write a short paragraph (4-6 sentences) in French describing your journey across different countries, mentioning at least three different modes of transport you used and why you chose them.
