

Rosa's Action Adventure: French Tenses

Learning objective: To identify and draw actions using French verbs in the present and past tense.

Follow the steps to draw your scene. Look at the word bank to help you label your drawing in French. Use the sentence starters to describe what is happening.

Draw: Draw a split-screen scene. On the left, draw a simple character (yourself) holding an apple with a speech bubble saying 'je mange'. On the right, draw the same character with an empty plate, with a speech bubble saying 'j'ai mangé'. Include a ball in the centre to show the action of playing. Use bright colours and clear outlines.



Label words: je mange (I am eating) · j'ai mangé (I ate) · je joue (I am playing) · j'ai joué (I played) · une pomme · un ballon

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw yourself eating a snack on the left side of your page. Label it 'je mange'.
2. Step 2: On the right side, draw yourself having finished your snack. Label it 'j'ai mangé'.
3. Step 3: Draw a ball in the middle. Write this sentence: Je joue avec...
4. Step 4: Draw a star next to the ball. Write this sentence: Hier, j'ai joué...
