

Rosa's French Diary: My Day

Learning objective: To use basic French verbs in the present tense to describe daily activities.

Help Rosa the parrot learn to write about her day in French. Use the word bank to help you choose the right verbs. Follow the sentence starters to write your diary entry. Remember: 'Je' means 'I'.

Word bank: mange (eats) · joue (plays) · regarde (watches) · chante (sings) · habite (lives) · le matin (in the morning) · l'après-midi (in the afternoon) · le soir (in the evening)

1. Le matin: Start your diary by writing what you eat or do. Sentence starter: Le matin, je... (2 marks)

2. L'après-midi: Write what you play or look at. Sentence starter: L'après-midi, je... (2 marks)

3. Le soir: Write what you sing or where you live. Sentence starter: Le soir, je... (2 marks)

4. Rosa wants to know: Can you write one sentence about where you live using 'J'habite à...'? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Try to add one French colour or a number to your sentences to make them even more interesting!
