

Rosa's French Verbs and Tenses Challenge

Learning objective: To understand and apply present and near-future tense structures in French, and to recognise common infinitive verbs.

Use these flashcards to test your knowledge of French verb patterns. Rosa the parrot suggests saying the French phrases aloud to practise your pronunciation!

What is the French infinitive for 'to play'?	How do you say 'I am' using the verb 'être'?
Jouer	Je suis
Translate 'I am going to eat' into French.	What is the 'aller' conjugation for 'nous' (we)?
Je vais manger	Nous allons
Translate 'She has' using the verb 'avoir'.	What is the English meaning of 'Je joue au football'?
Elle a	I play football (or I am playing football)
Which auxiliary verb is used to form the 'near future' tense?	Translate 'You (singular/informal) are' using the verb 'être'.
Aller (to go)	Tu es
What is the French infinitive for 'to have'?	Complete the phrase: 'Ils ____' (They are going) using the verb 'aller'.
Avoir	Ils vont
How would you express 'We are going to read' in French?	Translate 'Il a' into English.
Nous allons lire	He has
