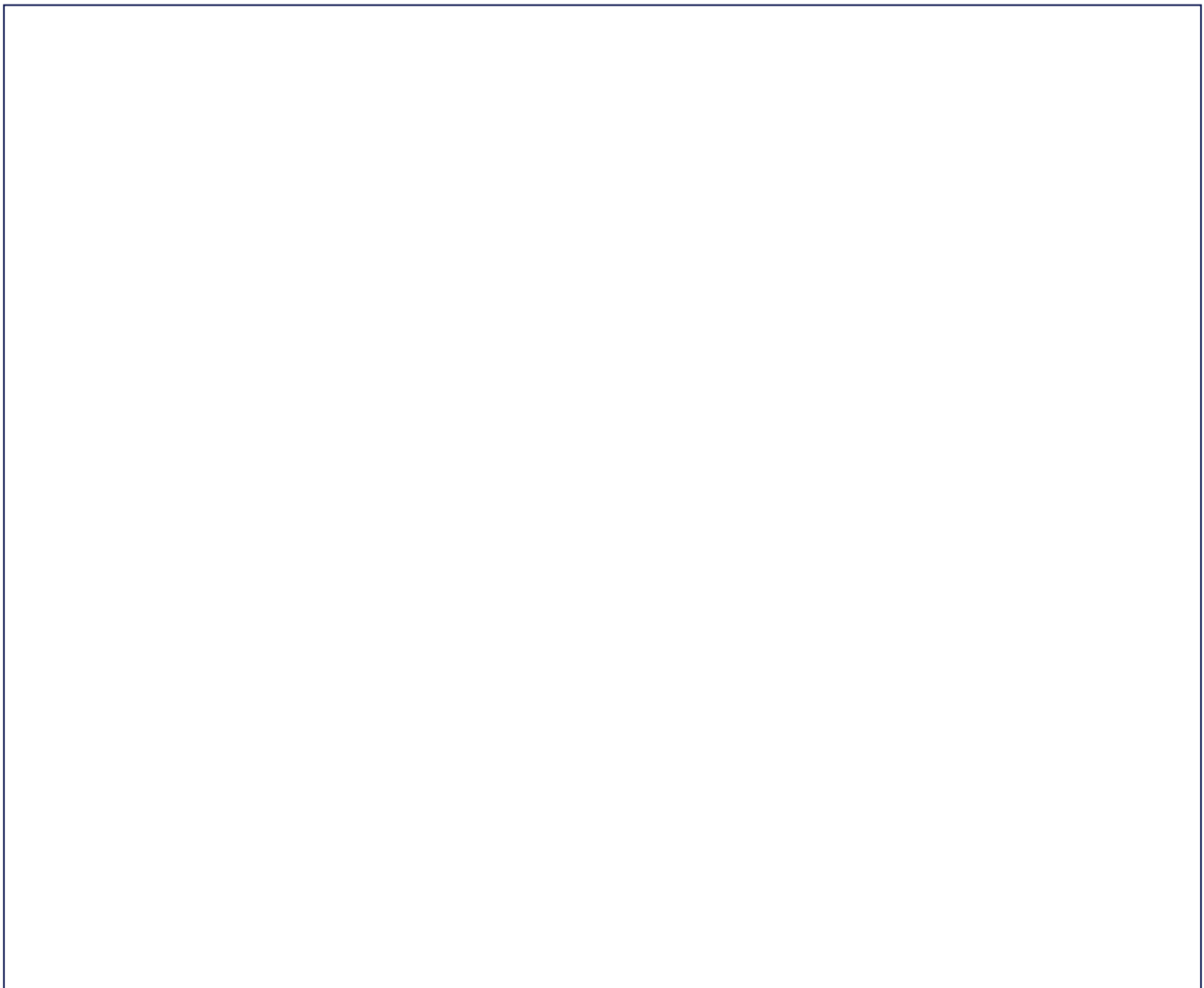


Exploring Africa with Finn the Dolphin

Learning objective: To identify and illustrate key geographical features of the African continent.

Follow the steps below to draw a map of Africa. Use your best drawing skills to show the different parts of the landscape. Use the word bank to help you label your picture.

Draw: Create a clear, simple map of Africa on your page. Use yellow or orange for the Sahara Desert in the north. Use bright green for the Savanna grass. Draw a blue line for the River Nile flowing towards the sea. Draw a tall, snowy-topped triangle for Mount Kilimanjaro in the east. Keep your labels neat and clear.



Label words: Sahara Desert · River Nile · Savanna · Mount Kilimanjaro · Equator

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw the shape of the continent of Africa. Draw a line across the middle and label it the Equator.
2. Step 2: Draw the long, winding River Nile in the north-east and label it.
3. Step 3: Draw a sandy area for the Sahara Desert and a grassy area for the Savanna. Label them both.
4. Step 4: Draw a tall mountain for Mount Kilimanjaro and add a label.
