

Finn's Asian Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and draw key geographical features found in the continent of Asia.

Follow the steps below to complete your map of Asia. You can use your coloured pencils to make it bright and clear. Use the word bank to help you label your drawing.

Draw: Draw a large map of Asia. Use the centre of the page for the mountains. Put the wall on the right side. Add the rice fields near the bottom. Make the ocean at the very bottom edge. Use bright colours for the trees and the water. Keep your lines neat.



Label words: Himalayas · Great Wall · Rice Paddy · Indian Ocean · Cherry Blossom Tree

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a tall, snowy mountain range in the middle of your page and label it 'Himalayas'.
2. Step 2: Draw a long, winding wall across a hill and label it 'Great Wall'.
3. Step 3: Draw some flat, watery steps for farming and label them 'Rice Paddy'.
4. Step 4: Draw some blue waves at the bottom of your page and label them 'Indian Ocean'.
