

Finn's Coastal Adventure: Label the Coast

Learning objective: To identify and name key physical features of a UK coastline.

Finn the dolphin is exploring the UK coastline. Look at the list of words below. Write the correct word next to the matching feature on the diagram. If you need help, use the word bank to find the right name.

Word bank: Cliff · Beach · Sea · Cave · Arch

1. 1. Look at the steep, tall rock face by the water. What is this called? (1 mark)

2. 2. Look at the sandy or pebbly area where the land meets the water. What is this called? (1 mark)

3. 3. Look at the hole in the rock shaped like a tunnel. What is this called? (1 mark)

4. 4. Look at the curved rock bridge over the water. What is this called? (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of a coastline. Include a tall cliff, a sandy beach, and the blue sea. Make sure you label your drawing using the words from the word bank.
