- A coast is the special place where the land meets the sea.
- A cliff is a high, steep rock face found by the water's edge.
- A beach is a shore covered in sand or pebbles, washed by the tides.
- A bay is a sheltered area where the sea curves inwards towards the land.
- A headland is a piece of hard rock that sticks out into the sea.

Did you know? Did you know? The shape of our coastline is always changing! Powerful waves crash against the rocks, slowly wearing them away. This process is called erosion. It can take hundreds of years to carve out a new arch or cave!
