Learning objective: To identify and describe the physical features of a UK coastline.

Word bank: coast · cliff · beach · sand · pebbles · tide · sea · erosion · waves

1. Where is your coastal area? (Name the place or describe its location) (2 marks)

2. What does the shore look like? (Are there sandy beaches or rocky cliffs?) (2 marks)

3. Describe one natural feature you can see at this coast. (2 marks)

4. How do people use this coast? (Do they swim, walk, or go fishing?) (2 marks)
