

Finn's Map of Europe

Learning objective: To identify and label key physical and political features of Europe.

Follow the steps below to complete your map. Use the word bank to help you label your drawing. You can colour your map to show land and sea.

Draw: Draw a large, clear map of Europe. Use a pencil to outline the coastlines. Use blue for the sea and green or brown for the land. Include a mountain symbol for the Alps. Keep your labels neat and use a ruler if you need to draw lines pointing to your labels.



Label words: United Kingdom · France · Italy · Spain · Alps · Mediterranean Sea · Atlantic Ocean

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw the shape of Europe in the centre of your page. Label the 'United Kingdom' at the top left.
2. Step 2: Draw the 'Alps' (a mountain range) in the middle of your map. How do you think mountains look on a map?
3. Step 3: Label the 'Mediterranean Sea' at the bottom of your map near Italy.
4. Step 4: Draw a blue line for the 'Atlantic Ocean' on the left side of your map.
