

Exploring Europe with Finn the Dolphin

Learning objective: To identify European countries and their capital cities, and to understand the location of Europe on a world map.

Finn the dolphin is swimming around the coast of Europe! Look at your classroom map or atlas. Use the word bank to help you answer the questions. Write your answers clearly on the lines provided.

Word bank: France · Italy · London · Paris · United Kingdom · Rome · Europe · Continent

- 1. Finn is visiting a large area of land that includes many different countries. What do we call this large land mass? (1 mark)**

- 2. The United Kingdom is a country in Europe. What is the capital city of the United Kingdom? (1 mark)**

- 3. France is a neighbour to the United Kingdom. What is the capital city of France? (1 mark)**

- 4. Italy is a country shaped like a boot. What is the capital city of Italy? (1 mark)**

- 5. Look at a map of Europe. Name one other country you can see on the map that is not in the word bank. (1 mark)**

Draw: Draw a simple map of Europe. Try to draw the shape of the United Kingdom and Italy. Label the sea around them blue.



Extension challenge: Finn the dolphin wants to travel to a country that starts with the letter 'S'. Can you find one on the map and write its name here?
