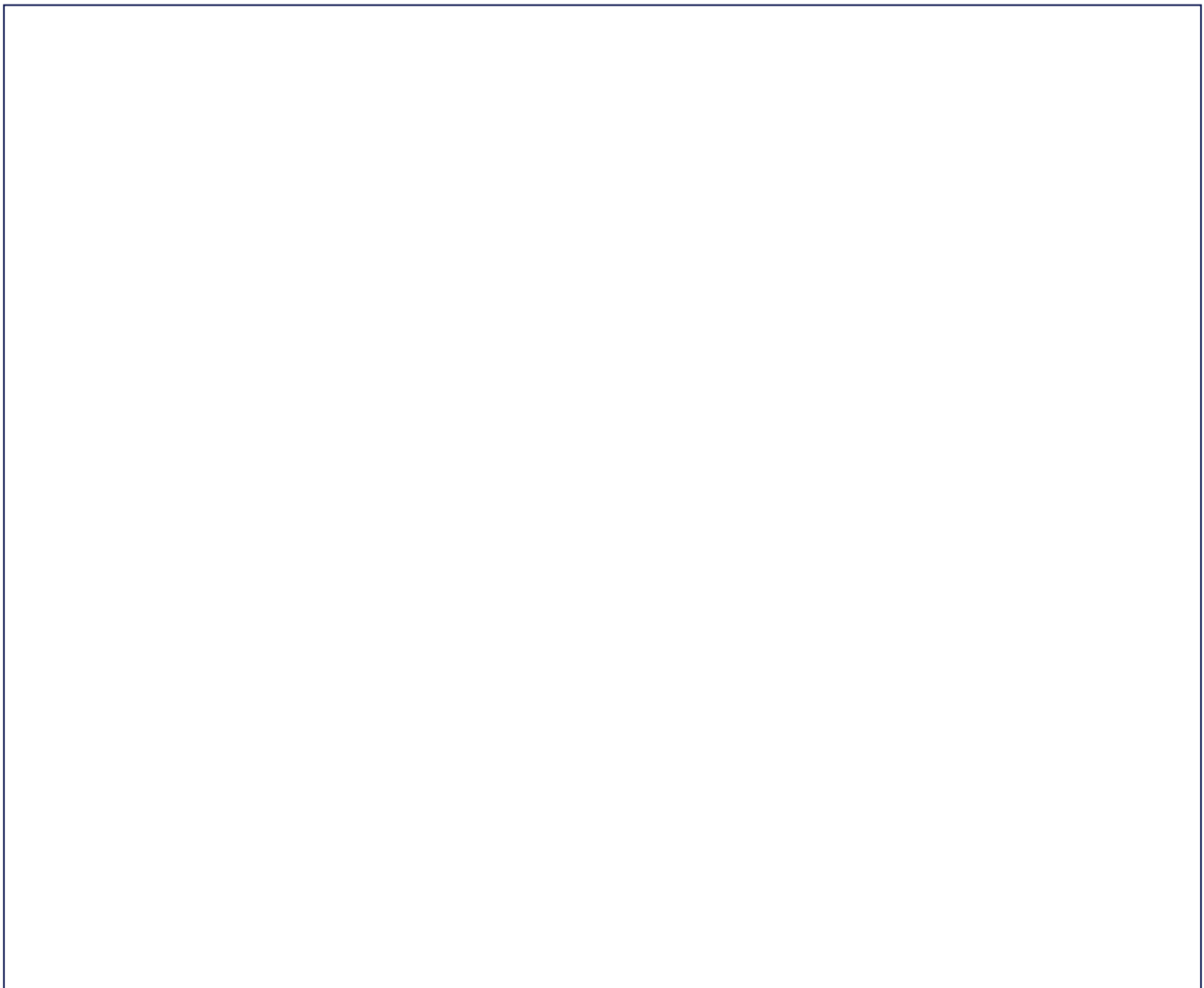


Exploring Mountains with Finn the Dolphin

Learning objective: To identify and label the physical features of a mountain environment.

Follow the steps below to draw and label your mountain scene. Use the word bank to help you label each part clearly.

Draw: Create a clear, simple landscape drawing on a piece of paper. Start by drawing a large triangle shape for the mountain. Add a smaller, flat area at the bottom for the valley. Use blue for the river and white for the snow at the top. Ensure there is enough space around your drawing to add labels with arrows pointing to the features.



Label words: peak · slope · valley · snow · river

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a tall mountain with a sharp top and a flat valley at the bottom. Label the very top of the mountain as the 'peak'.
2. Step 2: Draw some white colour near the top of your mountain to show where the 'snow' is. Label it.
3. Step 3: Draw a winding line coming down the side of the mountain to show a 'river'. Label the river.
4. Step 4: Label the side of the mountain where you walk up as the 'slope'.
