- A mountain is a very tall piece of land that rises high above the ground around it.
- Mountains are often found together in a long line or group, which we call a mountain range.
- The very top point of a mountain is known as the peak or the summit.
- The land between two mountains is usually a low area called a valley.
- Finn loves to look at maps to find where the biggest mountain ranges are hidden on Earth.

Did you know? Did you know? The very top of a mountain is called the summit. If you climb to the summit of a tall mountain, you might find snow even in the middle of summer because the air gets much colder the higher you go!
