

Exploring North America with Finn the Dolphin

Learning objective: To identify the location of North America and recognise some of its key geographical features.

Use the word bank to help you answer the questions. You can use your atlas if you have one!

Word bank: North America · Canada · USA · Mexico · Atlantic Ocean · Pacific Ocean

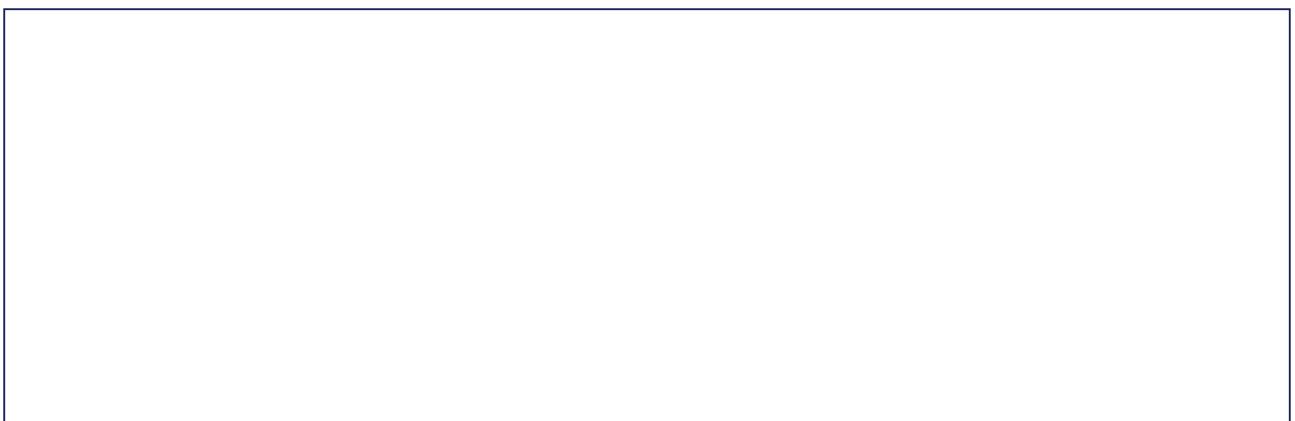
1. Finn is swimming around the world. Look at a globe or map. Which continent is home to Canada, the USA, and Mexico? (1 mark)

2. Name one country found in North America. (1 mark)

3. Finn the Dolphin is swimming off the East Coast of North America. Which ocean is he in? (1 mark)

4. Finn swims to the West Coast of North America. Which ocean is he in now? (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a map of North America. Try to draw the shapes of Canada, the USA, and Mexico. Draw Finn the Dolphin in the ocean next to the land.



Extension challenge: Can you find out the name of the very large mountain range that runs through North America? Ask a partner or use a classroom atlas to help you.
