

## Finn's Settlement Sorting Challenge

*Learning objective: To identify and describe different types of human settlements including villages, towns, and cities.*

Finn the dolphin is exploring the land! Help him sort these places into the correct group. Look at the size and features of each place. Cut out the descriptions (or write the number) to place them into the correct box: Village, Town, or City.

*Word bank: Village · Town · City · Small · Large · Shops · Houses · Roads*

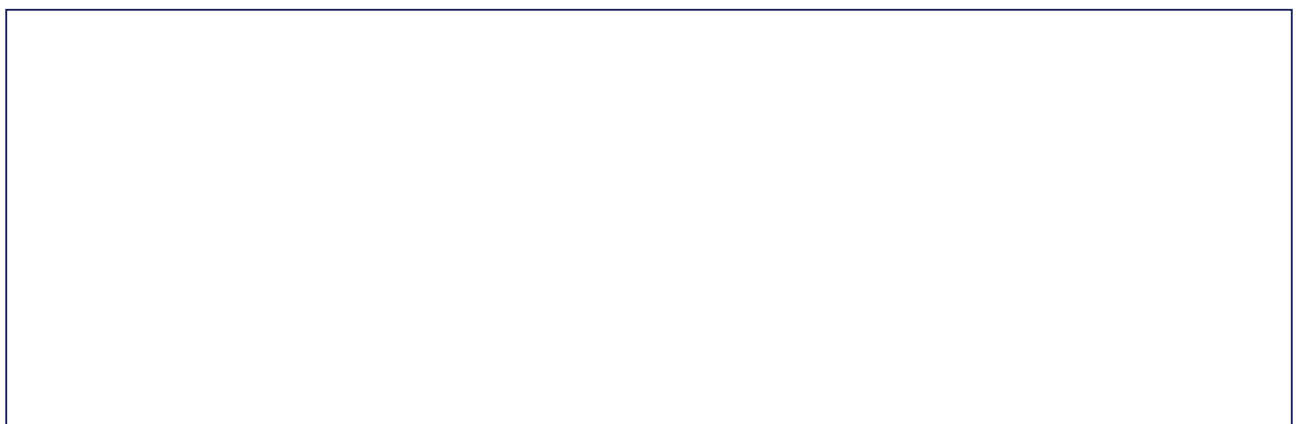
**1. 1. A place with very few houses and a quiet country road. Is it a Village, Town, or City? (1 mark)**

**2. 2. A busy place with many tall buildings, lots of traffic, and a large train station. Is it a Village, Town, or City? (1 mark)**

**3. 3. A place bigger than a village but smaller than a city. It has a high street with some shops. Is it a Village, Town, or City? (1 mark)**

**4. 4. Why do you think people choose to live in a town instead of a village? Use a word from the bank. (2 marks)**

**Draw: Draw a picture of a small village. Make sure to include a few houses, a tree, and a small road.**



*Extension challenge: Imagine you are building a new settlement. Would you build it near a river or a forest? Tell Finn why you chose that spot.*
