

Finn's Settlement Sketch

Learning objective: To identify and draw features of a human settlement.

Follow the steps below to draw your own village. Use the word bank to help you label your picture. You can use colours to make your village look bright and busy!

Draw: Draw a bird's-eye view (looking down from above) of a small village. Use simple shapes for buildings (rectangles for houses, squares for shops). Draw a winding blue line for the river and grey lines for the roads. Add green circles for trees in the park.



Label words: house · road · shop · school · park · river · farm

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a river running through your village. Label it.
2. Step 2: Draw three houses near the road. Label them.
3. Step 3: Draw a school or a shop. Label it.
4. Step 4: Draw a park with some trees. Label it.
