Finn's Map to Finding Homes: Explore how and why we settle!

- A settlement is a place where people build homes and live together in a community.
- Villages are small settlements. They usually have fewer houses and fewer shops than towns.
- Cities are large settlements. They often have many tall buildings, busy roads, and lots of people.
- People choose where to build settlements based on resources like water, food, and flat land.
- Transport links, like roads, bridges, and railways, help people travel between different settlements.

Did you know? Did you know? A settlement is any place where people live. The very first settlements were often built near rivers so people had easy access to fresh water for drinking and farming!
