

Exploring South America with Finn the Dolphin

Learning objective: To identify and draw key geographical features of South America.

Follow the steps below to create your map of South America. Use the word bank to help you label your drawing.

Draw: Draw a large outline of the South American continent. Use green for the rainforest area, blue for the river and oceans, and brown for the mountain range. Keep your labels neat and clear.



Label words: Amazon Rainforest · Andes Mountains · Amazon River · Pacific Ocean · Atlantic Ocean

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw the shape of South America in the middle of your page. Label the ocean on the left side 'Pacific Ocean' and the ocean on the right side 'Atlantic Ocean'.
2. Step 2: Draw a winding line through the top half of the land to show the 'Amazon River'.
3. Step 3: Draw tall, pointy triangles along the left edge of the continent to show the 'Andes Mountains'.
4. Step 4: Draw lots of leafy trees around the river to show the 'Amazon Rainforest'.
