

Exploring South America with Finn the Dolphin

Learning objective: To identify and describe key geographical features and countries of South America.

1. Find a country in South America. Write its name and one fact about it. (2 marks)

2. What is the name of the very long mountain range in South America? (2 marks)

3. Name one major river or forest found in South America. (2 marks)

4. Which two oceans touch the coasts of South America? (2 marks)

5. Is South America a country or a continent? How do you know? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Draw a map of South America and label the Amazon River and the Andes Mountains. Add a picture of Finn the Dolphin swimming in the sea next to the continent!
