

Exploring South America with Finn the Dolphin

Learning objective: To identify the location of South America and name some of its key geographical features.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you spell the names of places and features. Use short, clear sentences to write your answers.

Finn the dolphin is exploring the world! He is swimming all the way to South America. It is a large continent with many amazing places. From the tall mountains to the big, green rainforests, there is so much to see.

2. Name one of the two oceans that touch the coast of South America. (1 mark)

3. What is the name of the famous, large rainforest found in South America? (1 mark)

4. The Andes are a long range of what land feature? (1 mark)

5. South America is in the Southern Hemisphere. Is it north or south of Europe? (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of Finn the dolphin swimming in the ocean near the coast of South America. You could add some tall mountains or green trees in the background.



Extension challenge: Find South America on a globe or an atlas. Can you find the names of two countries that are in South America?
