

Exploring Ancient China with Ellie the Elephant

Learning objective: To identify and illustrate key features of life in Ancient China, including the Great Wall and traditional clothing.

Follow the steps below to create your scene of Ancient China. Use the word bank to help you label your drawing. You can colour your picture when you are finished!

Draw: Create a landscape scene of Ancient China. Include a tall, stone-textured Great Wall snaking across the top of a mountain range. At the base of the mountains, draw a calm, blue river. In the foreground, draw a person wearing a traditional flowing robe. Add a mythical dragon flying in the sky. Use bright colours and clear outlines.



Label words: Great Wall · River · Silk Robe · Mountain · Dragon

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a long, winding wall at the top of a hill. Label this the 'Great Wall'.
2. Step 2: Draw a wide river flowing at the bottom of the hill. Label this the 'River'.
3. Step 3: Draw a person standing by the river wearing a long 'Silk Robe'. Label the robe.
4. Step 4: Draw a 'Dragon' flying in the sky above the hills. Label the dragon.
