Learning objective: To identify and describe features of the local area and understand how places change over time.

4. 4. Which feature from the word bank is a 'Historical Feature'? (1 mark)

5. 5. If you could add one new thing to your local area to make it better for everyone, what would it be? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of your favourite place in your local area. Include one thing that is old and one thing that is new.



Extension challenge: Ask a family member: 'What was our local area like when you were a child?' Write down two things that have changed since then.
