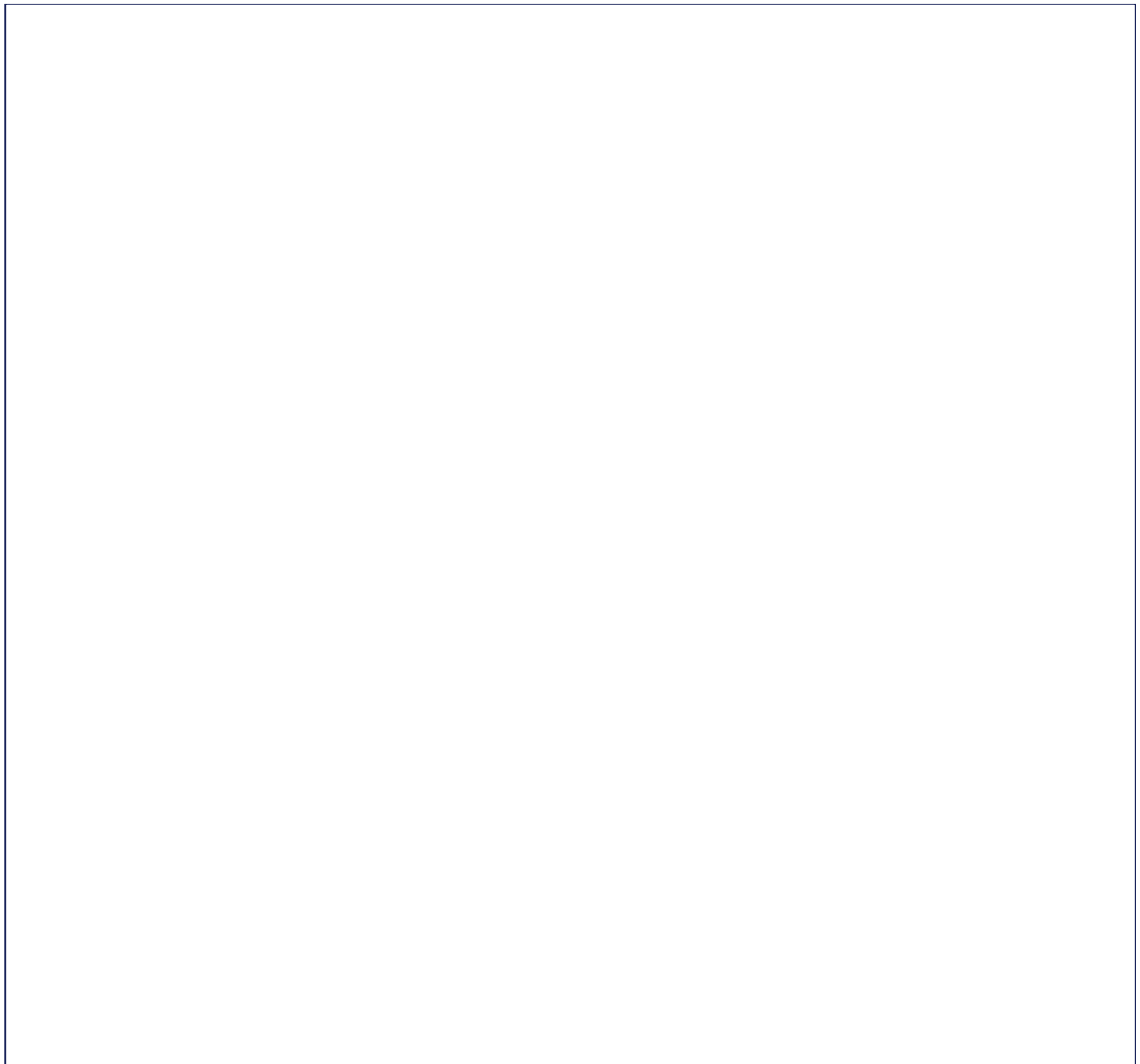


Max the Monkey's Market Maths

Learning objective: To practise addition of two-digit numbers using money (£).

Help Max the Monkey calculate the total cost of his fruit! Add the prices together, then colour in the scene.

Colour this: A friendly monkey named Max wearing a small waistcoat, standing behind a wooden market stall. On the stall are three baskets of fruit. Basket 1 has a price tag of £12 and £15. Basket 2 has a price tag of £24 and £13. Basket 3 has a price tag of £31 and £18. There are clean, bold outlines for the fruit (bananas, apples, and oranges), the price tags, and Max the Monkey. Leave plenty of white space for the children to colour the fruit and Max's waistcoat.



Steps:

1. Max buys a banana for £12 and an apple for £15. Label the total cost in the box provided.
2. Label the price tag on the basket showing the sum of £24 and £13.
