1. Max has 20 bananas and finds 25 more. How many bananas does he have in total? A) 35 B) 40 C) 45* D) 50 (1 mark)

2. What is the sum of 52 and 26? (1 mark)

3. If you have 30p and add 30p, how much do you have altogether? A) 50p B) 60p* C) 70p D) 100p (1 mark)

4. True or False: 15 + 15 is the same as 30. (1 mark)

5. Max buys a toy for £12 and a book for £12. How much does he spend in total? (1 mark)

6. Solve: $40 + 40 = ?$ (1 mark)

7. Which answer is the same as $7 + 8$? A) 13 B) 14 C) 15* D) 16 (1 mark)

8. True or False: $20 + 5$ is equal to 30. (1 mark)

9. Add 44 and 55. What is the total? (1 mark)

10. Max has 10p, 10p, and 10p in his pocket. How much money does he have? A) 20p B) 30p* C) 40p D) 50p (1 mark)
